Abstract

The Peer Educators in the Ethics of Research (PEER) program will provide a stipend for advanced graduate students and post-docs who complete research ethics training and then lead at least four (4) scheduled training activities related to UM's implementation of the federally mandated Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) program. (See www.miami.edu/rcr for description of the UM RCR Program.) PEER educators will complement the faculty educators now engaged in conducting mandatory RCR training sessions. The project is to fund a pilot implementation, assess its efficacy and report that outcome in appropriate venues.
